Support \$16B in federal funding to address critical needs:

- Economic Development: Fully enroll child care programs to make them financially sustainable and help parents find child care openings.
- Compensation for Providers: Improve compensation for those providing critical early education and care.

The ARPA Funding Cliff

If the ARPA funding shortfall isn't addressed:

- Small child care businesses may close.
- Parents might leave the workforce or take drastic measures,
 like asking teenage children to skip school to provide care.
- This leads to cascading negative effects on families, education, and the broader workforce.

Child Care Development Block Grant (CCDBG)

The 2024 CCDBG funding increase to \$8.7 billion (a 9% increase) is a positive step, but more funding is required, especially since ARPA funds expired in September 2023.
